
Phase 1

1. To create a larger 'Meet & Greet' Area at Hall entrance.
2. To move the ladies/disabled access toilets across the hallway.
3. To upgrade all toilets, adding good 'baby changing' facilities
4. To install a child's toilet made accessible from the Main Hall.
5. To replace the stage with a large storage area for our chairs and bowling mats, between the Woodrow Room/Main Hall.
6. To use the bottom right hand store in the Main Hall for Scouts, Guides, Youth Club and Badminton storage.
7. To install a water boiler in the Woodrow Room.
8. To create safer storage for chemicals & cleaning equipment.

Phase 2

To refit the Main Kitchen and refurbish the Main Hall.

Phase 1

1. To create a new Multi Purpose Room to accommodate our groups the that all ages.
2. To open up the Upper Area through moving the toilet/disabled toilet, adding good 'Baby Changing' facilities.
3. To allow walls to be opened up and to create visual space.
4. To provide needed storage within the Multi-purpose room.
5. To place the Kitchen within the Multi -Purpose room.
6. To repaint the whole area and add noticeboards.

To link up TV monitors to the Church AV.


